





You'll cycle from B&B to B&B, choosing your own preferred order. The B&Bs are housed in historic houses: an Art Nouveau villa from 1909 in Ghent, an original doctor's house from the 60's in Basel (near Antwerp) and an 18th-century square farm that has been "absorbed" by the city of Aalst ...

You will receive a proposal for the 3 routes: on paper and/or digitally.



Your bike will be waiting for you in the parking, with a fully charged battery if electric.

You can safely leave your car parked at every B&B, every B&B offers rental bicycles.



Your luggage can be forwarded and, if desired, you can order a picnic.

Each B&B gives you extra tips to adapt your city visit to your wishes. There is a full day's worth of beautiful experiences to be had, not only at the houses/cities but also along the way.

At each B&B you'll have the opportunity to spend a few days and visit the nearby city. Every B&B will offer extra value to those guests who spend at least two nights, as a free bonus!

Step 1: determine your start date, the number of vacation days and the order of the cities – for example:

Day 1 - arrival B&B 1:	<i>Villa Emma</i>	Day 5 – biking to B&B 3:	<i>B&B BAZ</i>
Day 2 - visit city 1:	<i>Gent</i>	Day 6 – visit city 3:	<i>A'pen</i>
Day 3 – biking to B&B 2:	<i>Hof beygaert</i>	Day 7 – biking to B&B 1:	<i>Villa Emma</i>
Day 4 – visit city 2:	<i>Aalst</i>		... back home 🤪

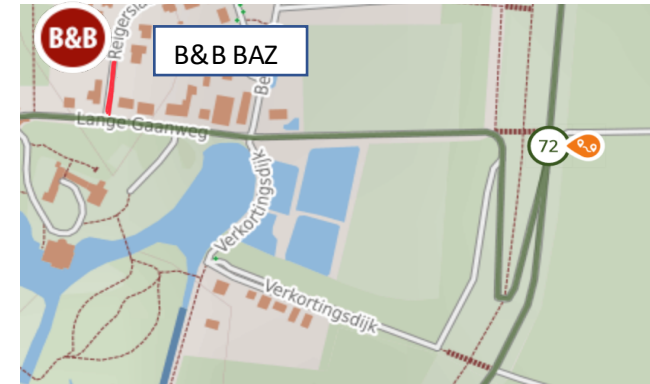
Select 24. Turn left into Lindenstraat, then 2nd left: Irisstraat, then continue down Lindenstraat. Go straight across Boudewijnlaan and again into Lindenstraat.



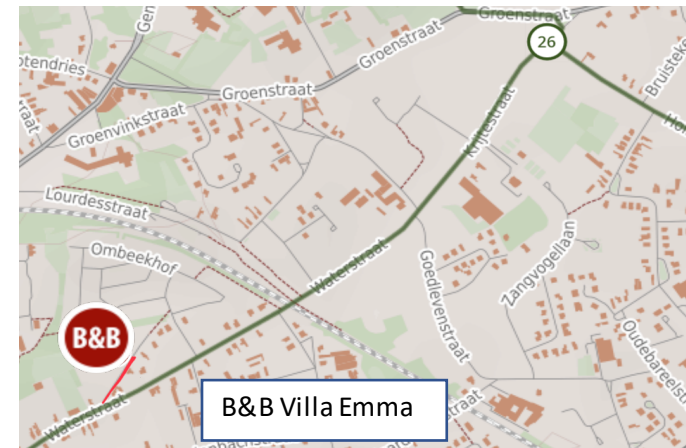

Drive down Lindenstraat to the end and turn left onto Welvaartstraat. Drive them to the end and turn left onto Oude Gentweg. Follow the N9 for 850 m and then turn left into Arbeidstraat. Now continue to 37

between Basel (Antwerp) and Aalst:

the castle of Wissekerke;
the castle and domain of Marnix van Aldegonde Bornem Abbey
the castle and domain of d'Ursel
the shipyard of Baasrode;

Between Aalst and Ghent:

Dendermonde's cloth hall;
city golf in Dendermonde
the "vlassenbroekpolder".
